No flip flops are to be worn to school.

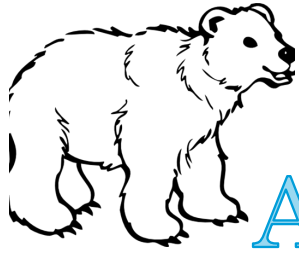
If you have any medication in school remember to pick it up by the last day of school, no medication can be sent home with a student.
